Drawing Competition

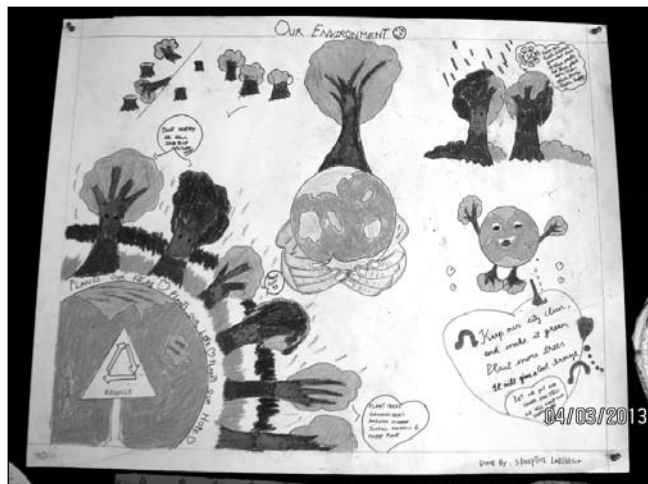
The School organized a Drawing Competition to contribute money for Cancer patients. The amount donated was Rs: 11,400/-

Killing animals for food, fur, leather, cosmetics, for use in Industrial & commercial products, etc is the most environmentally destructive practice taking place on the earth to-day.

Mechanical Slaughter Houses

- ◆ *Mechanical Slaughter houses are the greatest curse of modern civilization. They Result in Deforestation, Desertification, Water pollution, Water shortages, Air Pollution and Soil – erosion.*
- ◆ *About half of the world's grain is consumed by animals that are later slaughtered for meat. It takes 16 pounds of grain and soyabeans to produce 1 pound of beef. About 20 vegetarians can be fed on the land that it takes to feed 1 meat eater.*
